The revision of current eIDAS regulation introduced new concepts

- European Digital Identity Wallet (EUDIW)
- National public sector bodies responsible to issue credentials under eIDAS - Annex VI
 - 7. Educational qualifications, titles and licences;
 - 8. Professional qualifications, titles and licences;
- Different types of digital credentials
 - Personal Identification Data - PID
 - Electronic Attestations of Attributes
 - EAA
 - PUB-EAA
 - QEAA

Large Scale Pilot - Digital Credentials for Europe

Digital Credentials for Europe (DC4EU) is a multinational consortium, led by the Spanish Ministry of Economy and Digital Transformation, and is made up of +100 organisations from 25 countries (23 Member States of the European Union + Norway and Ukraine).

The purpose of the proposal is to develop large-scale pilots of the European Digital Identity Wallet (EUDIW) as defined in the revised eIDAS regulation and coming implementing acts.

Piloting use cases from two domains

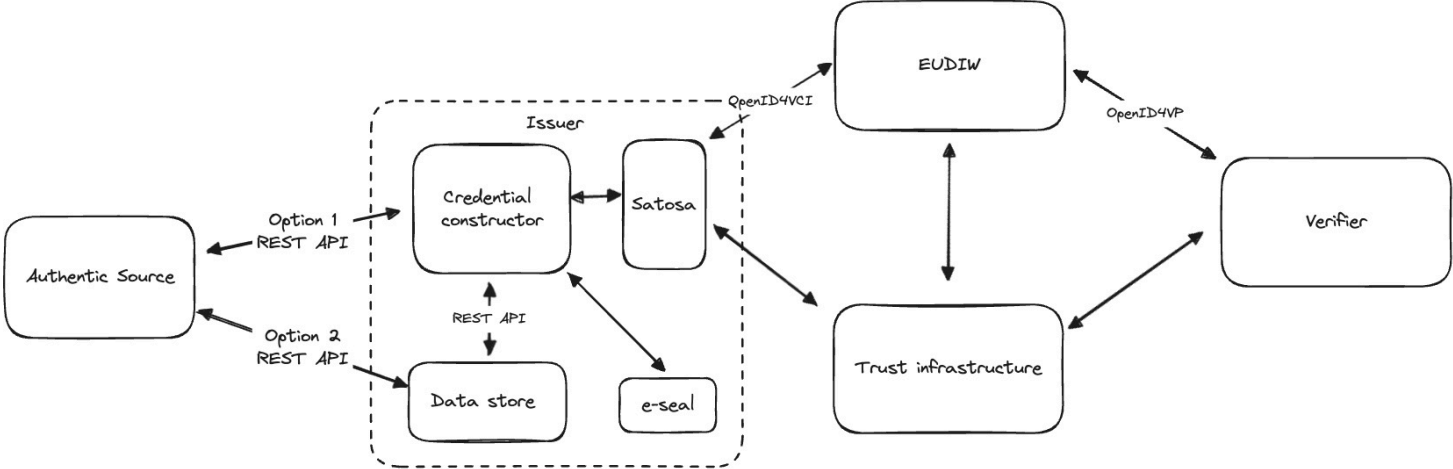
