### About KI Bibliometric Database

The primary aim of the Karolinska Institutet/SLL bibliometric database is to provide high quality bibliometric analyses for Karolinska Institutet/SLL. It is not possible to make certain who has actually written a publication by looking at a list of author names (usually including only initials instead of first names). To be able to make high quality analyses, all authors affiliated to Karolinska Institutet/SLL are therefore asked to verify their own publications and to supply information about at which organisational unit/units each individual publication was produced.

Bibliometric indicators are calculated for each publication that has been successfully verified. Indicators for an individual researcher

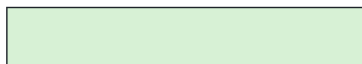
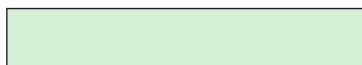

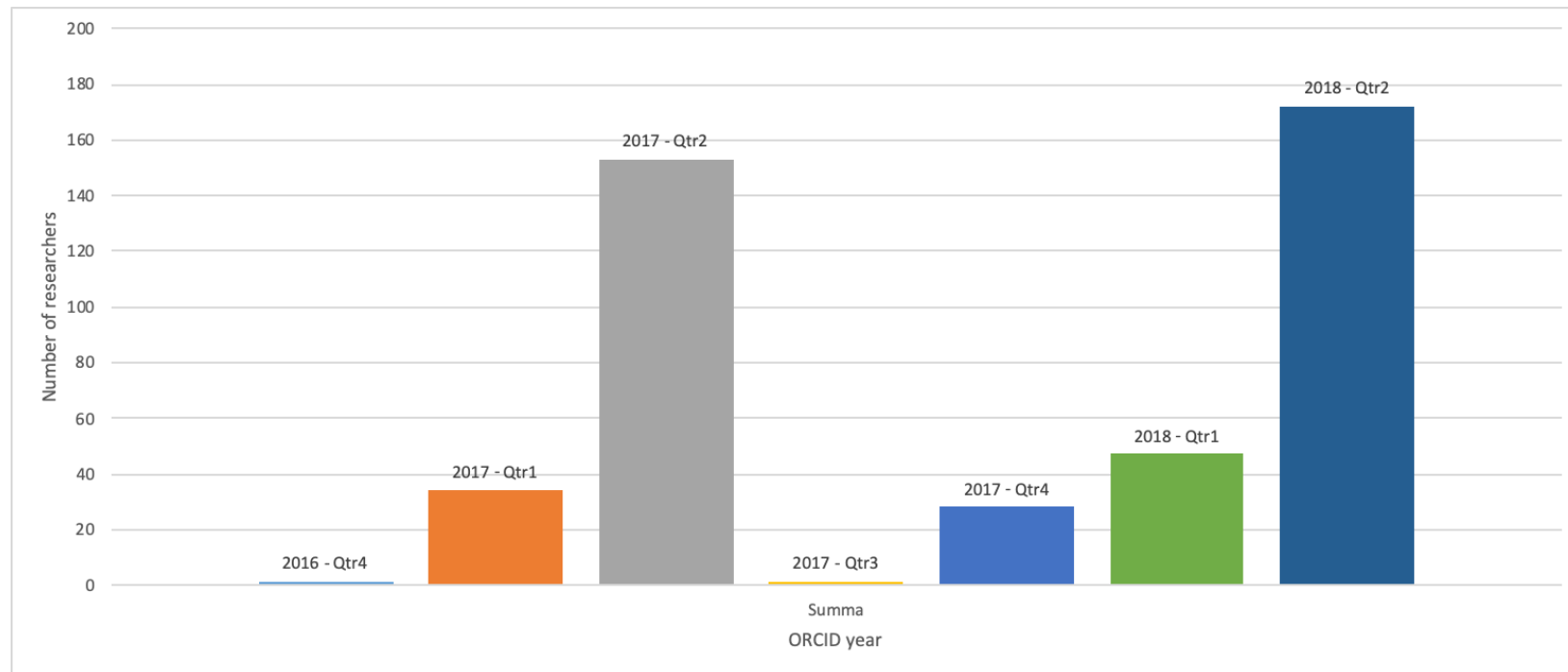
